<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Initial version is complete and turned in on time• Final version is complete and turned in on time• Presentation is given on day assigned
Subject Content: 60%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Image is well researched• Presentation has clear and effective introduction and conclusion• Basic background about the image is included (artist, title, date, medium)• Important features of image are clearly explained• Information about the image is presented in a logical sequence• Connection with cultural attitudes toward witches of the period is covered• Technical terms and concepts are clearly defined and specific persons, dates and places are appropriately identified• An appropriate amount of material is given in the presentation, and points made reflect well their relative importance
Digital Content: 5%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Image is well-formatted• Any textual elements are well formatted and appropriate
Delivery: 20%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Length of presentation is within the allotted time period• Speaker maintains good eye contact with audience, has good posture and physical presence and uses appropriate gestures.• Speaker speaks at reasonable pace with appropriate volume and avoids filler words and “uptones” at the end of sentences.• Speaker handles the technology smoothly and deals appropriately with any glitches
